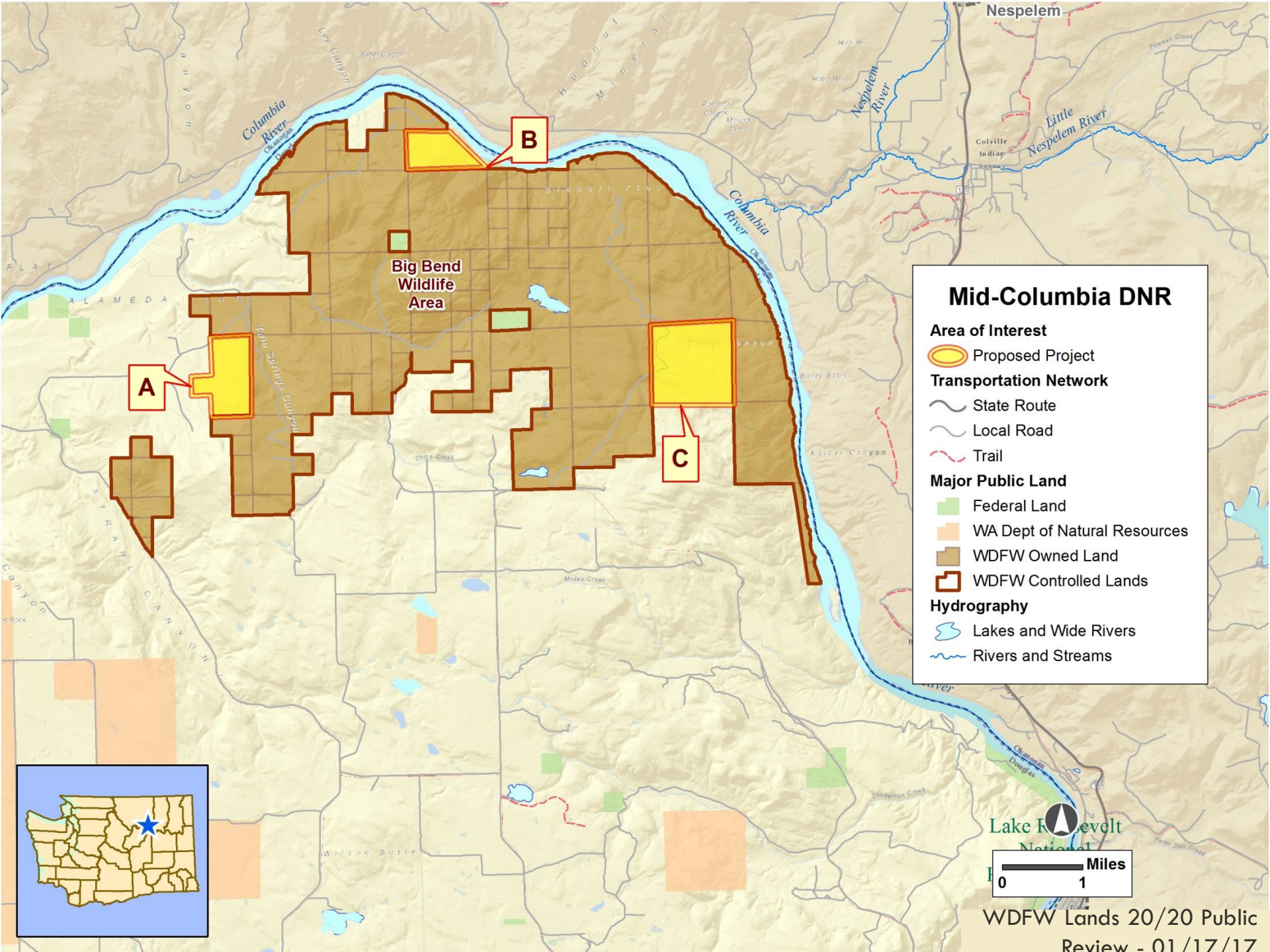




WDFW Lands 20/20 Public Review - 01/17/17

The project will coincide with WDFW’s recent and ongoing land purchase efforts to provide important connectivity for sharp tailed grouse in Douglas, Lincoln and Okanogan Counties.
