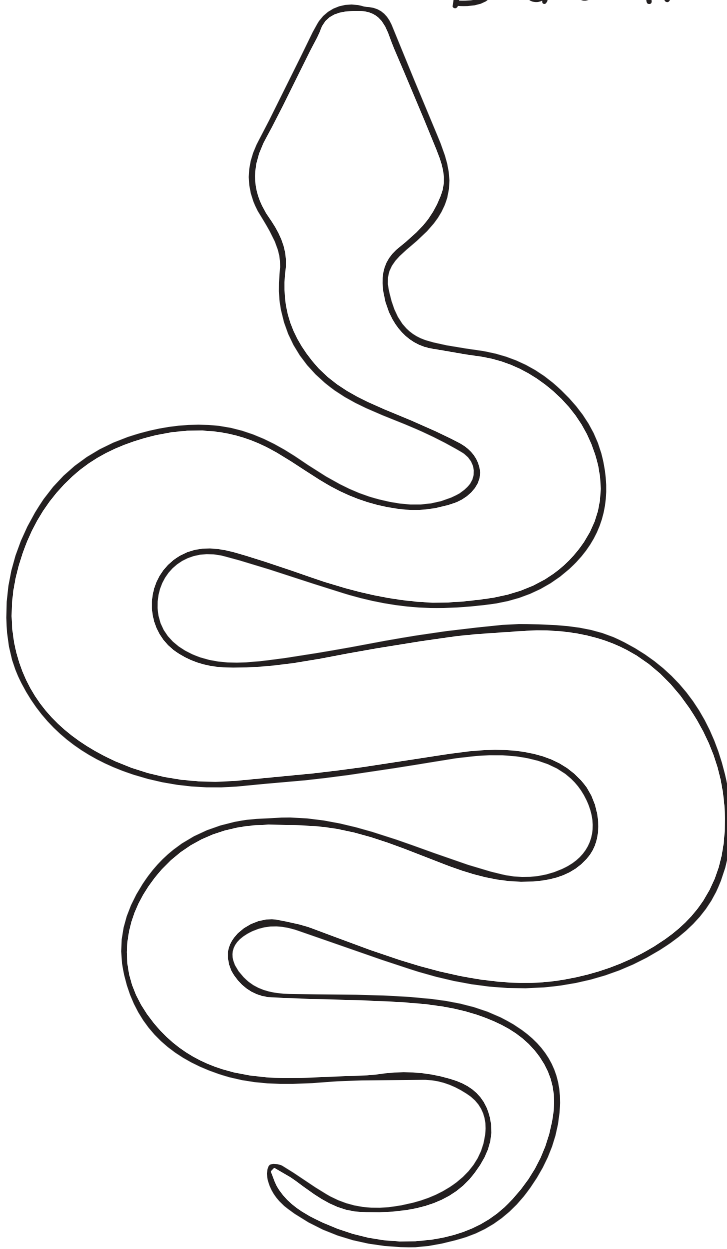


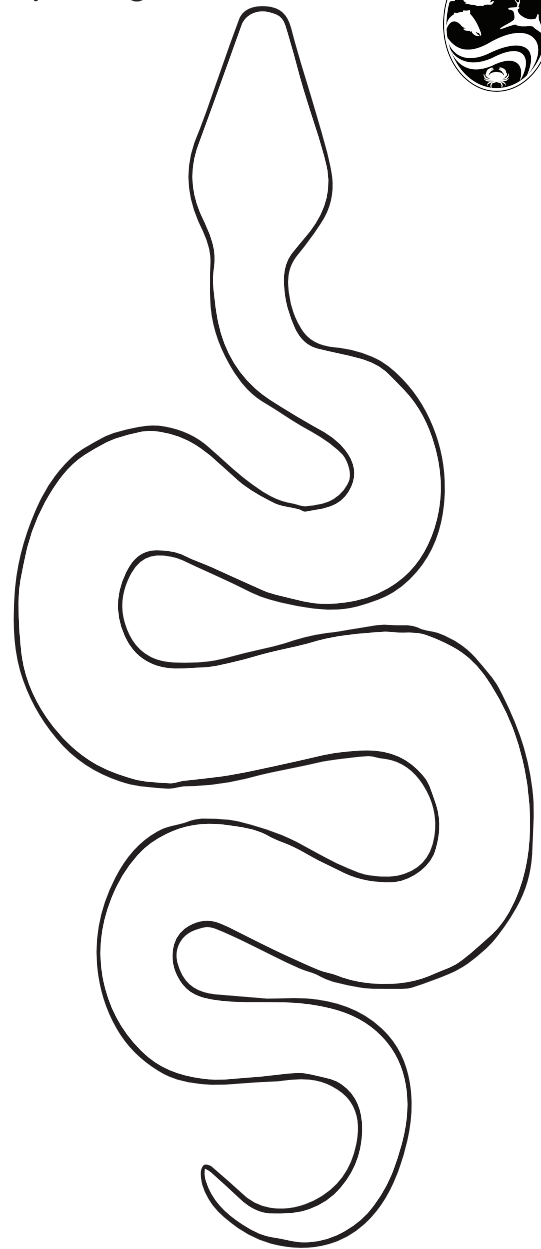
Rattlesnake or gopher snake?

Draw the differences



Northern Pacific Rattlesnake

- Rattle on tail
 - Vertical pupils in eyes like a cat
 - Two pits (holes) on face, near mouth
 - Diamond-shaped head
 - Body: large dark brown spots bordered by black then white.
- Tail has dark and light rings of equal width.



Gopher Snake

- No rattle on tail
 - Round pupils in eyes
 - No pits (holes) on face
 - Small head, flattens if threatened
 - Body: large brown/black blotches down back, small blotches on sides.
- Brown stripe runs jaw to jaw, across the eyes. Tear-like markings under each eye.
